## A Nobel Laureate's Life in Pictures

This year marks the 50th anniversary of the discovery of the Raman Effect by Dr. C. V. Raman. To mark this a photographic exhibition was held in Bangalore. Organised at the Raman Research Institute, the exhibition contained a rare collection of pictures illustrating several facets of the career and personality of the renowned scientist.

Photographs of Dr. Raman's ancestral home, family correspondence on scientific and other matters, various laboratories where Dr. Raman worked, places where he did research, the simple apparatus used by him to discover his celebrated effect, were some of the interesting exhibits which attracted the attention of visitors. One of the important aspects of the exhibition was the illustration

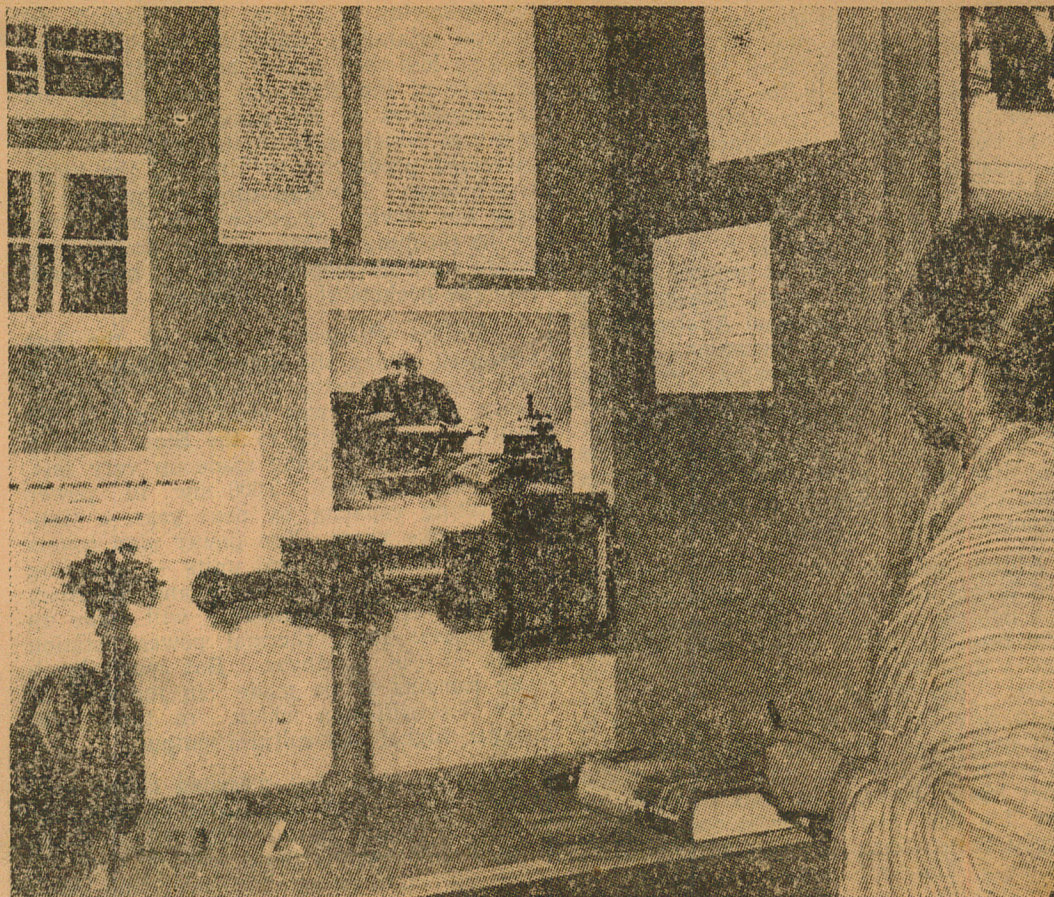
of a wide variety of phenomena investigated by Dr. Raman in a scientific career spanning over 66 years and of which the Raman Effect, although well known, was only a small part. His passion for colour and the numerous ways in which colour in nature fascinated him and led him to investigate their origin had also been well depicted.

There was also a display of a part of the collection of gems and minerals made by Dr. Raman. Hundreds of specimens of nature's most beautiful creations in the mineral world had been acquired by him over the years for their aesthetic appeal and as a source of inspiration for his numerous researches in crystallography and mineralogy.—Our Bangalore Staff Reporter.
