The Indian Institute of Science's (IISc) annual open day will be held on Saturday to showcase its activities to the student community and the general public.

Students and the public will have an opportunity to visit the institute and to go around the campus between 9 am to 5 pm.

The open day will feature popular lectures, experimental demonstrations, poster presentations, quiz contests, science competitions, and exhibitions by various departments and Centres.

There will also be a kid's zone offering special attractions for young students.

Entry to the event is free. Inside the IISc campus, visitors may use e-rickshaws to commute from one end to another.

Twelve e-rickshaws have been pressed into service and this service is available free of cost. On Friday,
